Personally identifiable information (PII) Policy

Personally identifiable information is collected by CARB for purposes of administering Section 4000.15 in the Vehicle Code, its related regulations, and for the purposes of assessing compliance with those regulations.

Any subsequent use of personally identifiable information shall be limited to the objectives consistent with those purposes previously identified. Personally identifiable information shall not be disclosed, made available, or otherwise used for purposes other than those specified, without the consent of the subject of the information, or as authorized by law.

As part of assessing compliance with the above mentioned regulations CARB will share the VIN information with California DMV for the purpose of enabling vehicle registration.

Information collected could be used for future research and analysis purposes.

Any personal information collected by the CARB is subject to the limitations in the Information Practices Act and state policy.

The personal information is protected against loss, unauthorized access, use, modifications or disclosure as per the CARB Data security Policy.
